**Course Description:** This course covers design, theory, compatibility, disassembly, assembly, parts fitting; trigger pull adjustments, maintenance, and troubleshooting of the Law Enforcement Pistol Armorer.

Each graduate will gain a complete understanding of the design theory, nomenclature, dynamics, detailed disassembly, assembly, maintenance and trouble shooting of the Colt "O" frame/1911 pistols.

**Graduation Requirements:** Students must demonstrate proficiency in the following areas: disassembly, assembly, identification of mechanical deficiencies and corrective actions. The student must also attain a score of 70% or better on the armorer's written test.

**Certification:** 3-year Colt's Law Enforcement Rifle/Carbine/SMG Armorer
