MGT 335 Event Security Planning for Public Safety Professionals is designed to provide planning and management level skills to officers from state and local law enforcement agencies, with the essential skills and knowledge to understand the importance and the need for planning and managing the security for special events and to identify guiding principles for special events security. The course is an adaptation of a non-certified Community Oriented Policing Services (COPS) curriculum. At the conclusion of this course, participants will be able to recognize and plan adequate strategies and security measures to prevent or mitigate security incidents related to planned events.

This **tuition-free** course is beneficial for FT/PT law enforcement, public officials, and others involved in planning an event.

Topics covered include but are not limited to:

- Review of the National Incident Management System (NIMS) and the Incident Command System (ICS) and their relationship to security planning and management.
- Descriptions and examples of events and venues, high-risk activities with security considerations, potential security incidents/hazards/exposures, and consequences to those incidents.
- Guiding principles for event security.
- Fundamentals of risk assessment (risk, threat, and vulnerability assessments).
- Key components of event security planning such as MOA's, emergency action plans, resource requirements, communications, etc.
